THE COOKIE SHEET

Australian cheese, garlic and chive damper (bread) Serves: 4

2 cups self-rising flour, sifted, ¹/₄ teaspoon salt, 1 ounce butter, in small pieces, 1 cup sharp tasty cheese, 2 tablespoons grated parmesan cheese, 1 garlic clove, 2 tablespoons chives, ¹/₂ cup milk, ¹/₂ cup water, 1 tablespoon parmesan cheese

Preheat oven to 425 degrees Fahrenheit

Sift flour and salt together in a large bowl. Using fingers rub in the chopped butter until it is the consistency of breadcrumbs. Add cheeses, garlic and chives. Mix well Combine milk and water. Make well in flour and pour in all the liquid, reserving a little for glaze. Mix quickly into a soft dough, using a knife or the hands.

Turn onto a lightly floured board and knead lightly. Press into a round. Place onto a grease baking tray. Glaze with leftover milk and water mixture and sprinkle with extra cheese.

Bake 15- 20 minutes in 425 F oven, and serve sliced with butter or olive oil.

Individual dampers can also be shaped and baked for the same time and temperature.
