THE COOKIE SHEET

Chicken tortellini soup with mushrooms and Spinach

2 tbsp. butter, ¼ cup carrot (chopped), 1 stalk celery (chopped), 1 medium onion (chopped), 1 tbsp. minced garlic, ½ tsp fresh thyme, 1 tsp Mrs. Dash, 8 ounces sliced mushrooms, 6 cups low sodium chicken broth, 9 ounces three cheese tortellini, 2 cups cooked chicken (chopped), 2 cups baby spinach leaves, loosely packed and fresh grated parmesan cheese.

In a large pot heat the butter until melted. Add the carrots, celery, onions, and garlic. Sauté until tender, about 8 minutes. Add the mushrooms, fresh thyme, and Mrs. Dash. Sauté another 5-8 minutes. Add the broth and heat to almost boiling. Add the tortellini and chicken and simmer until the tortellini are cooked through (about ten minutes). Add the spinach leaves and simmer for 5 minutes until the spinach is wilted. Serve hot, and top with parmesan cheese.
