LEMON BLUEBERRY DUTCH BABY

3 large eggs
3/4 cup (90 g.) all-purpose flour
3/4 cup whole milk
2 Tbsp. granulated sugar
Zest of 1 lemon
1/4 tsp. kosher salt
4 Tbsp. unsalted butter
1/2 cup fresh or frozen blueberries

Lemon curd and confectioners' sugar, for serving Preheat oven to 425°. Place a medium cast-iron skillet in oven to preheat. In a blender, blend eggs, flour, milk, granulated sugar, lemon zest, and salt until smooth and foamy, about 2 minutes. Place butter in preheated skillet and return to oven until butter is melted, 3 to 5 minutes. Carefully pour batter into center of skillet. Top with blueberries. Bake Dutch baby until golden brown and puffed, 20 to 23 minutes. Let cool 5 minutes. Top with lemon curd and dust with confectioners' sugar.
