NO-BAKE LEMON CHEESECAKE BARS

1½ cups graham cracker crumbs

5 tbsp melted butter

1 (8 oz) cream cheese (softened)

½ cup powdered sugar

1 cup heavy cream (whipped)

2 tbsp lemon zest

1/4 cup lemon juice

1 tsp vanilla extract

Blueberries (for topping)

Mint leaves (optional)

Press crust (graham + butter) into a pan. Whip cream cheese, sugar, lemon zest/juice, and vanilla. Fold in whipped cream. Chill 4+ hours. Top with berries.
