

THE COOKIE SHEET

CHOCOLATE ZUCCHINI BROWNIES

1½ cups grated zucchini (wrung dry)

1 cup all-purpose flour

½ cup cocoa powder

1½ tsp baking soda

½ tsp salt

½ cup vegetable oil

1½ cups sugar

2 tsp vanilla extract

1½ cups semi-sweet chocolate chips, divided

Preheat oven to 350°F (175°C). Grease a 9x9" pan.

Whisk flour, cocoa, baking soda, and salt.

In another bowl, mix oil, sugar, and vanilla. Stir in dry ingredients (batter will be thick).

Fold in zucchini and 1 cup chocolate chips.

Spread in pan, top with remaining chips. Bake 25-30 min. They will be fudgy!



YOU DON'T SAY
